## Driving up Green Lane

I have noticed a number of parents whizzing up Green Lane to drop children off at the gates, usually because they are late, though several were at 8.40am as the gates opened and they could have walked up. It also means that it is noticeable that several children are travelling in the front seats of cars when they are too short to do so. Please check your child's height before allowing them in the front seat. The law states that they should be 135cm tall or 12 years old.

## Lateness

We have a growing number of children who are arriving late to school. Please contact us if there is a problem with arriving at the same time as everyone else, and we will help. If social anxiety is an issue, we can arrange to take your child early so that you can avoid the rush. Many children feel anxious if they arrive late and it sets them up for a wobbly start to the school day. If they arrive a little early, they feel settled and calm, knowing they are where they should be and not missing out on anything. It can make a big difference to a child's behaviour and self-esteem.
